

To access the Peanut Lake wedding site, head north on First Street from the west end of Elk Ave. Go west (left) on Butte Ave. Butte Ave turns into a dirt road called Peanut Lake Road (County Road 4). Once the road turns to dirt, follow the road for approximately 0.55 miles. There will be a parking area on the right (east) side of the road. That is the main parking area for the venue. Continue to follow the road for another 0.1 miles, (just past the concreate mining structure on the left), and there will be another smaller parking area. The parking area has boulders on the backside and can only accommodate a limited number of vehicles. At the back end of the parking area, there is a small single-track trail that heads towards the lake past several Land Trust signs (the top one says "no camping"). Follow the that trail for about 130 feet towards the lake. The wedding site is located in the large meadow to the left of the trail.

Peanut Lake road is a very biking and hiking friendly road! We encourage all guest to hike or bike to the wedding site. Please be respectful to the land, tread lightly and please have all wedding activities remain inside the wedding site area.
